# A message from our Headteachers

Welcome back to the start of our new academic year! We are very excited about the year ahead and have lots planned for the children, parents and carers, and the community to be a part of.



You may have already have seen that we are working together with all stakeholders on our school values. We spent a lot of time last year creating our new school vision: Limitless Opportunity, Endless Potential. We would like our values to best represent this vision and ensure that they have meaning to the children.

We are asking for parents and carers to provide us with feedback and ideas on what our values should be, and would appreciate it if you could complete a short questionnaire to share your views. # <u>Attendance</u>

Our attendance target this year: 96%.
