An Overview of the Theme

<p>Mathematics Your child will be learning about place value. They will:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn about number and place value. They will work with numbers to one thousand and know how to represent and order these numbers. • Develop their knowledge of addition and subtraction of 3 digit numbers • Have daily fluency lessons where we will focus on number bonds within 20. • Have daily times tables practice of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
