Term: Summer I

An Overview of the Theme

This half-term, we are learning about the Ancient Egyptian Civilisation. We will be using a range of historical inquiry skills to help us learn more about this period of history including chronology, comparing similarities and differences as well as interpreting different sources. We will also be learning about Egypt as a country and using our geographical skills to locate this on a map.
