Term: Summer 1



## An Overview of the Theme

This half-term, our theme in Year 4 is mountains and rivers where we will be working up to answering our enquiry question: Are mountains and rivers useful to us?

## **English** Use subordinate clauses and subordinating conjunctions. Your child will be writing: To use expanded noun phrases. To use headings and subheadings appropriately. Setting description Non-chronological report Use paragraphs based around a theme. Retelling a story of a river's Use fronted adverbials. To use a range of descriptive writing techniques. journey To convert between kilometres and metres. Mathematics Your child will be learning about perimeter, To find perimeters of shapes. To work out missing lengths of shapes. length and fractions. To find solutions to problems involving perimeter. To look at fractions that are greater than 1. To convert between mixed numbers and improper fractions. To know how to identify equivalent fractions. To be able to simplify fractions.

To learn to add and subtract fractions with the same denominator.

To learn to subtract a fraction from a whole number. To understand how to find a fraction of an amount.

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Year 4 will be going on a trip to Perlethorpe during the Summer 2 half term to try river dipping. This will link to our topic theme of Rivers and Mountains from our Summer 1 half term.

Homework	Children will be sent home spellings every Friday in a spellings book and your child	
	must remember to bring this to school <b>on the following Wednesday</b> for their spellings test.	
	Children will be sent home a half-termly homework project with different tasks to	
	complete. Your child should aim to complete these over the half-termly period.	
	We are quickly approaching June whereby all year 4 pupils in the country will take	
	a multiplication test in which they must be fluent in their times tables up to 12 x	
Times Table	12. The test will provide a random times table and be on the screen for 5 seconds	
Test – June	before moving onto the next one. This test will be taken on an iPad. Your child has	
	a Times Table Rockstars login to practise on the mode 'soundcheck'. Please try to	
	encourage them do their times table daily. If you own a tablet, we encourage that your	
	child practices on one as the test will be taken on one. There are lots of interesting	
	things to do on the app, such as earning coins to dress up their rock star avatar and	
	compete on the class leader-board. As a pass mark, we are looking for children to get	
	a score of at least 20/25. Currently, 59% of the class are achieving this! Our class target	
	is 80%.	
Daily	Please write in your child's diary each time you read or support in anyway at home.	
Reading	Please get your child to read as much as possible to improve their reading skills.
