An Overview of the Theme

This term we will be learning all about who the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings were.

English We will be using the book and film 'How to Train your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell. From this, we will produce writing outcomes of: Instructions of how to train a dragon. A diary entry as one of the characters from the book. A setting description based on the film. We will: **Mathematics** Your child know how to find the value of each digit in numbers to 1,000,000. will be know how to partition numbers in different ways. compare and order numbers up to 1,000,000. learning about place represent numbers in different ways, including with Roman Numerals. value to identify the position of a number on different number lines. 1,000,000, compare and order numbers to 1,000,000 and addition round numbers to the nearest, 10, 100, 1,000, 10,000 and 100,000. and add and subtract numbers with up to five digits. subtraction. use the column method for addition and subtraction. round numbers to estimate answers to problems. add and subtract mentally solve problems involving addition and subtraction.
