English Your child will be writing; retells of familiar stories and innovating their own! Mathematics Your child will be learning about place value, addition, and subtraction	<ul> <li>know how to count to 10 confidently</li> <li>know how to write numbers to 10</li> <li>know how to compare numbers</li> <li>know how to add I digit to I-digit numbers using objects</li> <li>know how to subtract a I-digit number from a I-digit number</li> </ul>
