An Overview of the Theme

This half term, we will be exploring:
How is Nottingham different to London?

English

Your child will be writing; retelling a story, innovating their writing and creating a persuasive letter.

- Use of capital letters and full stops
- Use of conjunctions
- Using the correct tense
- Apply phonological knowledge to help spell words
- Accurate spelling of common exception words such as could, should, where etc
- Use noun phrases for description
- Explore commands, statements, exclamations and questions.

Mathematics

Your child will be learning about addition, subtraction and place value

- Know my numbers to 100
- To know how to add and subtract 1 digits from 2 digits
- To compare and order numbers
- Count in 2's, 5's 10's
- Count in 3's.
- To add and subtract.
