













Year 6 Curriculum Overview - Summer 2

Please find information below about what your child will be learning about in each subject area over the next half term.

<p><u>Curriculum theme for this half term</u></p> 	<p>This half-term, our theme in Year 6 will be continuing our learning about The Americas, learning and exploring more about the continent working up to answering our enquiry question:</p> <p>How are the Americas different to the United Kingdom?</p>
<p><u>Reading - Books we will be reading this half term</u></p> 	<p>Our class text this half term is: The Man Who Walked Between the Towers by Mordicai Gerstein. <p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p>In Writing this term, Class 6 will be writing to inform, entertain and persuade. They will be looking at the features and structures of: explanation texts; horror / mystery stories; and balanced arguments. They will then use their skills to produce their own texts.</p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p>In Maths this term, class 6 will be applying their understanding of mathematical subjects to problems solving activities and projects.</p>
<p><u>Science</u></p> 	<p>In Science this term, children will be recapping and extending their knowledge of the human circulatory system as well as developing their understanding of living things and their habits, including: classification of living things and evolution and inheritance.</p>
<p><u>Geography</u></p> 	<p>In Geography, class 6 will be exploring the Americas. They will explore what the Americas are; identify its position in relation to other parts of the globe; describe the climate; and answer the question: how does the USA differ from the UK?</p>

<p><u>Art</u></p> 	<p>In Art this term, class 6 will be looking at printing with painting and the art of screen-printing.</p>
<p><u>Design Technology</u> (DT)</p> 	<p>In DT this term, Class 6 will be working with food. In connection with the theme of Americas, class 6 will be creating pancakes and discussing the nutritional values of their topping choices.</p>
<p><u>Religious Education</u> (RE)</p> 	<p>In RE children will be exploring the question: Where does RE fit in the world today?</p>
<p><u>Personal, Social and Health Education</u> (PSHE)</p> 	<p>In PSHE this term, Class 6 will be looking at changes: How do we change as we grow up. They will also be looking at relationships and what the ingredients are for a healthy relationship.</p>
<p><u>Music</u></p> 	<p>Class 6 will be developing their pitch, tone and performance skills for their end of year performance.</p>
<p><u>Physical Education</u> (PE)</p> 	<p>This term, Class 6 will be developing their striking and fielding skills whilst developing their understanding of the game Rounders.</p>
