
















Foundation 2 Curriculum Overview - Summer 2

Please find information below about what your child will be learning about in each subject area over the next half term.

<p><u>Curriculum theme for this half term</u></p> 	<p>This half term our theme will be 'Who helps us?' We will be thinking about people from across the community that help us from teachers, lollipop people, postal workers, nurses, police and even more! We will also be exploring different transport!</p> <p>We will also be thinking about how we help others now and what we would like to be when we grow up.</p>
<p><u>Reading - Books we will be reading this half term</u></p> 	   
<p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p>We will be continuing to develop our writing skills through Drawing Club. Each week, we explore a new text/story and create pictures and sentences based on characters/settings. This half term we will be performing poetry and writing our own as a class!</p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p>We will be developing our understanding of numerical patterns such as finding doubles, halving and explored odd and even numbers. As always, we will be continuing to practice our number formation. This is something children can also practice at home!</p>
<p><u>Understanding the world</u></p> 	<p>We will be exploring the people in our local community that help us. If you or anyone you know is in a role where they help or support the local community, we would love for you to come and visit! We will also continue to observe how the seasons are changing!</p>
<p><u>Personal, social and emotional development</u></p> 	<p>We are continuing to develop our group work. Working in partners and teams is a tricky skills to learn, however we will be working on listening carefully to others and responding to their ideas. This includes participating in group-based activities actively.</p>
<p><u>Communication and language</u></p>	<p>We will be continuing to work on our 'speaking in full sentences' just like experts do!</p>

	<p>We are also going to be develop our questioning skills- making observations whilst developing our curious minds to find out more!</p>
<p><u>Expressive art and design</u></p> 	<p>We continue to develop our art and design skills through activities in the classroom. Children have access to a wide range of materials and tools and are encouraged to experiment. This half term we will be exploring different artists and talk about the process of creating our artwork.</p>
<p><u>Religious Education (RE)</u></p> 	<p>We will be exploring special stories and learning/retelling different special stories from a range of different faiths.</p>
<p><u>Music</u></p> 	<p>We will be using our voices and different instruments to create the sounds of different transport that is used by people who help us!</p>
<p><u>Physical Education (PE)</u></p> 	<p>We will be developing our co-ordination and ball skills through different games. We will be practising striking a ball with different bats and balls!</p>
