Reading - Books we will be reading this half term	We will be reading a variety of books about families and where we live.
Writing	In our writing lessons this half term we will be:  - Applying our phonics knowledge to form sentences that we can read ourselves  - Orally rehearsing sentences, forming letters and numbers accurately  - Using 'and' to extend sentences  - Learning the difference between adjectives and nouns.  - Using adjectives to describe characters.  We will be continuing our writing skills through Drawing Club.
