



## Year 1 Curriculum Overview - Spring 2

Please find information below about what your child will be learning about in each subject area over the next half term.

<p><u>Curriculum theme for this half term</u></p> 	<p>The theme for the half term is "Would you like to live in castle" We will be visiting Nottingham Castle and designing them, as well as reading about who lived in castles.</p>
<p><u>Reading - Books we will be reading this half term</u></p> 	<p>We will be using a mix of books, animations and oral storytelling to provide a wide range of texts including the <i>The Knight Who Said No</i> and <i>George's Dragon</i> along with other tales of castle and royalty.</p>
<p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p>We will be carrying on with Drawing Club using our reading books as stimulus for writing.</p> <p>We will continue to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-orally rehearse sentences.</li> <li>-form capital letters and numbers accurately</li> <li>-use 'and' to extend sentences</li> <li>-use adjectives to describe characters</li> <li>-understand the difference between a noun and an adjectives.</li> <li>-using 'I' to write in the first person</li> </ul>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p>We will continue to correctly form numbers and count backwards and forwards confidently to 20.</p> <p>We will specifically be learning to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• add and subtract within 20</li> <li>• know numbers to 50</li> <li>• measure length and height</li> <li>• understand capacity and mass</li> </ul>
<p><u>Science</u></p> 	<p>We will continue to learn about how the seasons change and about different types of weather. We will be recording the daily temperature for comparison across the seasons. We will also be continuing to</p>

	explore different types of materials and their properties.
<p><u>Art</u></p> 	We will be learning about sculpture and using natural resources inspired by Andy Goldsworthy. We will be producing some transient art using nature and its different shapes and colours.
<p><u>Design Technology (DT)</u></p> 	We will be investigating how simple wheeled vehicles work by looking at axles. We will explore a variety of types and wheels and axles and then make our own simple wheeled vehicle to assist in a fire!
<p><u>Religious Education (RE)</u></p> 	We will discover why different faiths believe we should care for the world including Hinduism, Islam and Christianity.
<p><u>Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE)</u></p> 	We will be learning about how to stay healthy including what to eat, drink and how to exercise to keep our bodies healthy.
<p><u>Music</u></p> 	We will continue to learn with our music specialist teacher, Mr Stanton this half term. We will be learning about different rhythms and learn to play these on a variety of different percussion instruments from around the world.
<p><u>Physical Education (PE)</u></p> 	We will continue with gymnastics this half term, learning to control our bodies whilst travelling in different directions and balancing in different ways. We will create and evaluating short sequences alone and in pairs.
<p><u>History</u></p> 	We will be learning about the Normans, William the Conqueror and when the original Nottingham Castle was first built. We will learn about the features of castles through the ages and the jobs that people would have done in castles.
