




Year 2 Curriculum Overview

<p><u>Curriculum theme for this half term</u></p> 	<p>Our key questions this half term is:</p> <p><u>Why was Mary Seacole a significant person?</u></p>
<p><u>Reading - Books we will be reading this half term</u></p> 	
<p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p>We will be learning to authors by writing our own adventure narrative. We will also be writing a job description for a nurse and a nonfiction text about the life of Mary Seacole.</p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p>We will be continuing to develop our multiplication and division skills.</p>
<p><u>Science</u></p> 	<p>We will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will be considering these questions: What are living things? Where do they live? How do they survive?</p>
<p><u>History</u></p> 	<p>We will be learning all about the life of Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale at the time of the Crimean War.</p>

<p><u>Religious Education</u> (RE)</p> 	<p>We will be considering the key question: What is a prophet?</p>
<p><u>Personal, Social and Health Education</u> (PSHE)</p> 	<p>We will be learning about how to be healthy and happy through our Jigsaw 'Healthy Me' topic.</p>
<p><u>Music</u></p> 	<p>We will be practicing our performance skills with Mr Stanton, ready for the Whole School Music Performance later in the year.</p>
<p><u>Physical Education</u> (PE)</p> 	<p>We will be learning about invasion sports in PE.</p>
<p><u>Computing</u></p> 	<p>We will be using artistic software on purple mash.</p>
