














EYES Curriculum Overview

Summer 1

Please find information below about what your child will be learning about in each subject area over the next half term.

<p><u>Curriculum theme for this half term</u></p> 	<p>This half term our theme will be 'Go outside!'. We will be exploring the outdoors, the seasons and learning how plants grow. We will be using our outdoor spaces to discover flowers, trees and minibeasts! We will also be introducing a forest school afternoon every Wednesday to support children's learning! We will be having a bring a plant/dress up day to start this very exciting topic!</p>
<p><u>Reading - Books we will be reading this half term</u></p> 	
<p><u>Phonics</u></p> 	<p>Foundation 1- Children are continuing to learn the SATPIN sounds and identify the sound at the start of the word. Some children will begin to hear words when they are sounded out to them!</p> <p>Foundation 2- Foundation 2 have been working very hard on their phonics and have now completed Phase 3! We will now be working on reading longer words with more than one syllable and adjacent consonants for example 'help' 'went' as these can be tricky to sound out!</p>
<p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p>We will be continuing to develop our writing skills through our phonics learning and writing independently in the classroom. Foundation 2 will create their own versions of Jack and the Beanstalk in Drawing club. Each week, we explore a new text/story and create pictures and sentences based on characters/settings. These stories inspire the different activities in the classroom.</p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p>Foundation 1 will continue to explore numbers from 1-10, counting object and practising number formation. Foundation 2 will deepen their understanding of numbers to 10 by finding one more and one less and comparing quantities. We will also be exploring measurement!</p>

<p><u>Understanding the world</u></p> 	<p>We will be exploring our natural world, thinking about the changing seasons and that plants and trees grow. We will be thinking about different plants in our local environment but also explore and discuss plants/flowers etc in different parts of the world. We will also investigate what plants need to grow!</p>
<p><u>Personal, social and emotional development.</u></p> 	<p>We are continuing to develop our group work. Working in partners and teams is a tricky skills to learn, however we will be working on listening carefully to others and sharing. This includes participating in group based activities actively.</p> <p>We will also be thinking about how we keep ourselves healthy and clean!</p>
<p><u>Communication and language</u></p> 	<p>We will be exploring new vocabulary linked to our new topic and speaking like scientists (in full sentences) to explain observations in our environment.</p>
<p><u>Expressive art and design</u></p> 	<p>We continue to develop our art and design skills through activities in the classroom. Children have access to a wide range of materials and tools and are encouraged to experiment.</p>
<p><u>Foundation 2 specific subjects</u></p>	
<p><u>Religious Education (RE)</u></p> 	<p>We will be learning about 'special things'. We will discuss which objects are special to us before exploring special objects in different religions for example prayer beads.</p>
<p><u>Music</u></p> 	<p>We will be using our voices, bodies and instruments to explore different types of transport, identify and mimic transport sounds before performing!</p>
<p><u>Physical Education (PE)</u></p> 	<p>We will be developing our co-ordination and ball skills through different games. We will be practising striking a ball with different bats and balls!</p>
