










Summer 1- 'Go outdoors'

<p>Reminders</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please leave your child at the door in the morning to further their independence. • Children need to be in school uniform, with a school/blue jumper cardigan. • Please provide your child with spare clothes, just in case! • Please ensure all belongings are labelled with children's names.
<p>How can you help at home?</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practice putting shoes on- this is a great skill for children in EYFS to master! • Talking about our new topic, using the knowledge mat- communication development is very important in EYFS. • Keep sending in pictures of key family events or anything you have done linked to our topics. We love to share these. • Visiting the library, exploring different books/stories together.
<p>Forest school</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Every Wednesday afternoon, children in EYFS take part in forest school. We will be going outside into our very own Warren forest to explore the changing nature, the wildlife and plants. • Please provide your child with wellies and water.proofs/overalls for this day if you have them! Forest school can get muddy but it is a great way to develop children's understanding of the natural world.



Foundation 2 specific information

<p>PE this half term for Foundation 2</p> 	<p>PE day reminder- PE is on a Thursday PE kit reminder - Children need to come to school dressed in their school PE kit.</p> <p>Children in F1 develop their physical development in our outdoor classroom.</p>
<p>Homework</p> 	<p>Each half term, a knowledge mat will be shared. This includes talking points (topics to discuss with your child), example of books we are reading and a selection of projects to choose from!</p> <p>Children will also bring home flashcards. This may include numbers, key sounds they are working on, words or tricky words (words they can't always sound out). It would be great if when reading with your child, you take some time to practice these. It has a fantastic impact on their progress!</p>
<p>Reading at home</p> 	<p>Children should be reading at home every day. This can be as little as 5 minutes, but this makes all the difference! Every book has phonics sounds, tricky words and key vocabulary for the children to practice. Ask your child questions about the story, what words mean and to point key pictures out etc.</p> <p>Please bring these to school every day and we will change the children's books when they are ready to move on!</p> <p>Just spending time listening to and sharing stories makes all the difference. Especially with communication and language!</p>
