














## Year 1 Curriculum Overview - Summer 2

Please find information below about what your child will be learning about in each subject area over the next half term.

<p><u>Curriculum theme for this half term</u></p> 	<p>This half term our theme will be Ocean protectors! We will be exploring what is happening to our oceans and seas. By becoming Geography experts we will use maps and atlases to find the names of the oceans and seas. We will think about the animals that live here and how to protect them. We will also study different jobs people do to look after the oceans.</p>
<p><u>Reading - Books we will be reading this half term</u></p> 	  
<p><u>Writing</u></p> 	<p>We will be continuing to become more confident when writing longer pieces. We will retell and create our own version of the Lighthouse keeper's lunch. We will be writing lots of non-fiction writing about the oceans and even a letter to David Attenborough!</p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> 	<p>We will be developing our understanding of fractions, position and direction and telling the time!</p>
<p><u>History and Geography</u></p> 	<p>We will be exploring the people in our local community that help us. If you or anyone you know is in a role where they help or support the local community, we would love for you to come and visit! We will also continue to observe how the seasons are changing!</p>
<p><u>PHSE</u></p> 	<p>We are continuing to develop our group work. Working in partners and teams is a tricky skills to learn, however we will be working on listening carefully to others and responding to their ideas. This includes participating in group-based activities actively.</p>

<p><u>Art/DT</u></p> 	<p>We continue to develop our 3D drawing skills to sketch animals from the seas.</p> <p>In DT we will be researching, designing and making a range of healthy snacks, practicing safe cutting skills.</p>
<p><u>Religious Education (RE)</u></p> 	<p>We will be exploring the key question 'Why should we care for others?' We will explore a range of beliefs and faiths to understand why this is important in our world.</p>
<p><u>Music</u></p> 	<p>We will be exploring different musical symbols to represent tempo, dynamics and rhythm in music to represent under the sea animals and atmosphere.</p>
<p><u>Physical Education (PE)</u></p> 	<p>We will be developing our striking and fielding skills. We will practice accurate throwing and catching and using different bats to develop our striking skills. We will then apply these skills to a variety of games!</p>
