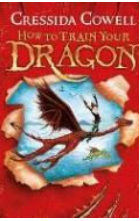
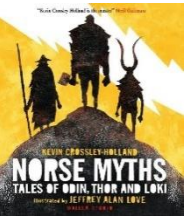
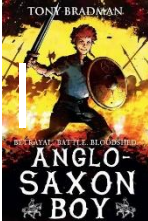
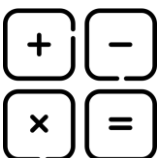


Year 5 Curriculum Overview - Autumn 1

Please find information below about what your child will be learning about in each subject area over the next half term.

<u>Curriculum theme for this half term</u> 	<u>Our Theme will be Anglo-Saxons and Viking</u>  
<u>Reading - Books we will be reading this half term</u> 	  
<u>Writing</u> 	<u>We will be writing:</u> • Instructions on how to train a dragon, based on the book. • A diary entry as an Anglo-Saxon child • A setting description
<u>Maths</u> 	<u>Our Maths units will be:</u> • Place Value • Addition and Subtraction • Multiplication and Division
<u>Science</u> 	<u>Forces</u> • We will be exploring and understanding a range of forces, including gravity, air resistance and water resistance.
<u>Geography</u> 	<u>Anglo-Saxons and Vikings</u> • We will be exploring maps and routes the Vikings used to come to Britain.
<u>History</u> 	<u>Anglo-Saxons and Vikings</u> • This half term will explore different settlements, ways of life and why/how the Vikings invaded Britain.

<u>Art</u> 	<u>Drawing</u> We will exploring the artist Gustave Calliebotte, and exploring his work during the impressionism movement,
<u>Religious Education (RE)</u> 	<u>Why do people have to stand up for what they believe in?</u> We will be exploring different religious perspectives, understand religious freedom and understand challenged people have faced.
<u>Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE)</u> 	<u>Being me in my world.</u> We will be exploring the question 'Who am I and where do I belong?' whilst understanding, rights and responsibilities.
<u>Music</u> 	<u>Mr Stanton</u> The children will continue to develop their performance skills and skills on a range of instruments wit Mr Stanton.
<u>Physical Education (PE)</u> 	<u>Athletics</u> The children will develop their athletic skills by understanding pace and speeds of running, running in a relay, and different types of jumps and throws.
<u>French</u> 	<u>Vikings</u> In line with our history learning, the children will also learn how to say some basic phrases about the Vikings in French.
<u>Computing</u> 	<u>Quizzing</u> The children will explore what makes an effective and engaging quiz, and will work towards creating their own.
