

## Dynamic Risk-Benefit Assessment Process

### OPEN OBSERVATION

- Playing alongside
- Trust and caring interest
- Non-intrusive

### FOCUSED ATTENTION

- Some warning signs, play and risk escalating
- Proximity and Check-ins
- Dialogue and reflection
- If improves, go back to open observation

### ACTIVE INTERVENTION

- Immediate change, steps to reduce risk
- Empowering language
- Safety Prompts
