## School Behaviour Policy

As we prepare to return and open the school to more children, we are writing to clarify our school's expectations around behaviour when children return.

Although our Behaviour Policy already covers expected standards within school, we have written an addendum to this policy to reflect the school's expectations linked to the current Coronavirus pandemic. A copy of the behaviour policy addendum has been sent with this letter and is available on the school's website.

Our priority, as ever, is ensuring the safety and well-being of children and staff. In order to achieve this, we have carried out a thorough risk assessment of the school and put in place measures, recommended by the Government, including social distancing, hygiene expectations, small teaching groups, additional cleaning and other key protective measures.

The expectation is that all children returning to school will follow rules and guidance. We accept that our younger children will need additional help and support from staff to follow these guidelines and, as ever, our staff will be very positive in how they remind younger children of how they can stay safe.

The guidance from the Government is also clear that should anyone show any signs of COVID-19, that they will not remain on the school site.

### ***What to do if someone develops symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) whilst at an educational setting***

- *If anyone develops coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms in an education setting they must be sent home and advised to follow the staying at home guidance.*
- *If a child is awaiting collection, they should be moved, if possible, to a room where they can be isolated behind a closed door, depending on the age of the child and with appropriate adult supervision if required. Ideally, a window should be opened for ventilation. If it is not possible to isolate them, move them to an area which is at least 2 metres away from other people.*
