



## F1 2020-2021

All the staff here at Warren are very much looking forward to having the children back in September, looking smart in their uniforms and ready to learn and succeed and as their new class teacher, I can't wait to meet them all properly and get started on all the excitement a new academic year brings. Below are some important details to explain what September will look like for your child and their class mates and to provide details of new systems you and your child will need to follow:



### The start and end of the day

- F1 will be returning the week beginning 7th September and the date for your child starting will be sent to you.
- F1 children need to be dropped off at the field gate, from Muirfield Road at 9.10am. We will collect the children, line them up then escort them up to the F1 classroom.
- F1 children need to be collected at 2.45pm at the gate on the park side of the school. Parents will need to line up on the path and your child will be sent to you.
- If your child is a part time child attending the morning sessions and they are collected at dinnertime, they need to be collected at 11.40 from the Hall, from the door near reception.
- If your child is a part time child attending the afternoon sessions, they need to be dropped off at 12.15 at the hall and collected at 2.45 from the field gate, from Muirfield Road.
- Drop off and collection times must be adhered to in order to avoid the children mixing with other classes/year groups. Unfortunately, you will not be able to go past the drop off point with your child to speak to me; however, we believe communication is vital so please use Dojo or call the school office if you wish to speak to me and I will get back to you as soon as possible.

### Hygiene

- The children will be regularly encouraged to wash their hands and use hand sanitiser and will have their own pack of stationery. They will follow the one-way system inside and outside the building.

### Playtime and lunchtime

- The F1 children will have lunch in the F1 area and will have sole use of the toilet inside the F1 classroom. Lunch will be eaten in the classroom and the children must bring in their own water bottle.

### Resources

- All children will be provided with a pack of stationery so must not bring a pencil case with them.
- Children should only bring a small bag containing a change of clothes and a packed lunch if they have one.



**Curriculum:**

The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) is a very important stage as it helps your child get ready for school, as well as preparing them for their future learning and successes. During this period there will be a key focus on nurturing their independence and developing their social skills, which lays the foundation for more formal teaching later on. The Early Years curriculum has 7 areas of learning :-

- Communication and language
- Physical development
- Personal, social and emotional development
- Literacy
- Maths
- Knowledge of the world
- Expressive arts

**English:**

We will be following the Early Years curriculum for the teaching of English (known as literacy in the EYFS curriculum) which focuses on the teaching of phonics, reading and speaking and listening skills. They will get lots of opportunities to practice and develop their skills in a rich and engaging play based environment.

**Maths:**

We will be following the Early Years curriculum for the teaching of Math and as with English they will get lots of opportunities to practice and develop their Maths skills in a rich and engaging play based environment.

**PE:**

The F1 children do not get changed for PE. The PE lessons will focus on fitness and stamina rather than team games until further notice.
