# F2 Summer Term Newsletter

## English

In English this term we are focusing on key authors. We will be looking books by Eric Carle and Julia Donaldson.

We will be learning letter sounds and applying this to reading and writing simple words.

We will also be focusing on learning to read and write the first set of key words (please see your child's reading diary in September).

There is also a big focus on letter formation in this first term by making sure that pupils are starting their letters in the right places and going in the right direction. This is very important as later on in the school they will be joining up their writing.

## Maths

During this term we will be building the children's knowledge and understanding of shape, addition and subtraction as well as developing their number recognition and counting skills. In F2 the children are expected to be able to recognise and use numbers up to 20 confidently.

To build understanding we will be focusing on a different number every 2 weeks. During that time, the children will practise finding different ways to make the number. During the Autumn term, we will be consolidating the children's understanding of the numbers 1 to 10.
