

Home Learning Tasks Year 1 Week beginning 20th July, 2020

Maths

Challenge 1 - Try the Bitesize maths lessons for Year 1 if you can. Make sure you can count in 2s, 5s and 10s. <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/znfk8xs>

Challenge 2 - Some of you have told me that you have been learning to tell the time. Amazing! In Year 1 we need to be able to tell the time to o'clock and half past and recognise on both an analogue clock and a digital clock. You could learn the language of time - earlier, later, before, after, yesterday, tomorrow. You could learn the days of the week in order and the months of the year (if you don't already know them!) 

For example, Doritos are triangles, cut carrots into cylinders, cut slices of cucumber into thin circles, cherry tomatoes are spheres. How many different shapes can you make? (and then eat!)
