1. Find a record as many 2-D shapes as you can in your house or outside. Make a tally to find out which shape is the most common.
2. How many different quadrilaterals can you draw?
3. Make some what am I shape cards just like we did in school. Fold a piece of paper in half and draw the shape on the inside and write 2 facts on the front. Example: I have 5 vertices. My sides are different lengths. What am I? (pentagon)
