An Overview of the Theme

This half-term, our theme in Year 5 is Traders and Raiders.

<p><u>English</u> Your child will be writing; diary entries and non-chronological report.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • write different kinds of sentences – simple, compound and complex. • use a range of co-ordinating and subordinating conjunctions. • begin to use relative clauses. • identify the audience and purpose for writing. • use structured models to help write independently. • write substantial paragraphs. • propose changes to vocabulary, grammar and punctuation to enhance meaning. • be introduced to parenthesis in writing.
<p><u>Mathematics</u> Your child will be learning about place value to 1,000,000, and addition and subtraction.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • know how to find the value of each digit in numbers to 1,000,000. • know how to partition numbers in different ways. • compare and order numbers up to 1,000,000. • represent numbers in different ways, including with Roman Numerals. • identify the position of a number on different number lines. • round numbers to the nearest, 10, 100, 1,000, 10,000 and 100,000. • add and subtract numbers with up to five digits. • use the column method for addition and subtraction. • round numbers to estimate answers to problems. • add and subtract mentally • solve problems involving addition and subtraction.
