Term: Summer 2

An Overview of the Theme

This half-term, we will be continuing our theme in Year 4 which is the Ancient Greeks, where we will be working up to answering our enquiry question:

What impact have the Ancient Greeks had on society today?

English

Your child will be writing:
 A Greek myth
 A Greek God profile
 A poem

- Use subordinate clauses and subordinating conjunctions.
- Organising writing through paragraphs relating to key ideas.
- Use co-ordinating conjunctions and compound sentences.
- Use adverbs of time, place, manner and frequency including fronted adverbials.
- Use of third and first person.
- Use commas for lists.
- Use past, present and future tense appropriately.
- Use apostrophes to mark singular and plural possession.
- Use implied second person
- Use prepositional phrases
- To know the structure of a narrative, linking the opening and the ending
- Use inverted commas correctly to show direct speech
- Use reporting verbs and clauses correctly

Mathematics

Your child will be learning about decimals, money, time, geometry and statistics.

- To work out what is needed to make a whole (decimals)
- To write, compare and order decimals
- To round decimals to the nearest whole number
- To learn the decimal equivalents of fractions
- To write money in pounds and pence using a decimal point
- To order, add and subtract amounts of money
- To know what change is and how to find it
- To solve simple worded problems involving money
- To convert between units of time
- To write time in different ways & compare times by converting units
- To solve problems involving time
- To recognise obtuse, right and acute angles
- To understand regular and irregular shapes & name and describe quadrilaterals and triangles
- To identify lines of symmetry in shapes and patterns
- To present data in pictograms, bar charts and tables
- To solve problems based on data
- To explore line graphs
