Term: Summer 2

An Overview of the Theme

This term, our theme in Year 3 is Ancient Egypt where we will be working up to answering our enquiry question:
Who were the Ancient Egyptians?

English

Our English book this term is 'Cinderella of the Nile'. Your child will be using writing skills to:

- Write adventure narratives
- Write setting descriptions
- Write instructions
- Practice writing ascending and descending letters.
- Practice the spelling of high frequency words.

Mathematics

Your child will be learning about fractions, capacity and money:

- Develop their understanding of denominators and numerators
- Learn about different values of money
- Develop their knowledge of how to problem solve
- Learn how to check their answers in different ways
- Have daily fluency lessons where we will focus on our times tables

This half term some of the year 3 pupils will be attending the camping trip, for those not attending we will be doing activities in school. We are also planning an Egyptian day, this will be on Friday 14th July.
