An Overview of the Theme

This half-term, we are continuing with our theme of Anglo-Saxons and Vikings.

English	 This half herm, we will be focusing on the book 'Arthur and The Golden Rope'. The children will be using this to create their own narratives, about a quest, similar to the one Arthur goes on in the story. They will also be using their historical knowledge built on throughout the term to write a non-chronological report for a historical journal.
Mathematics Your child will be working on multiplication and division and fractions.	 Recognise and find multiples and factors Recognise and identify prime numbers Calculate square and cube numbers. Multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1,000. Multiply and divide by multiples of 10, 100 and 1,000. Find and use equivalent fractions. Convert between improper fractions and mixed numbers Compare and order fractions. Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator. Add and subtract fractions including mixed numbers where one denominator is a multiple of the other. Solve word problems involving fractions.
