An Overview of the Theme

This half-term, we are beginning to look at the Industrial Revolution in Britain, but we will be focus on science, with our 'Out of this World' theme for Earth and Space.

English	 This half herm, we will be focusing on the book 'Counting on Katherine' by Helaine Becker, exploring the story of how Katherine Johnson helped astronauts get into space. Our secondary text will be 'Cosmic' by Frank Cottrell-Boyce. The children will be using this to write a biography all about Katherine Johnson, and Newspaper reports about the first landing on the moon.
Mathematics Your child will be learning all about fractions and multiplication and division.	 Add and subtract fractions, including mixed numbers, where one denominator is a multiple of the other. Solve word problems including fractions. Multiply a number up to 4 digits by a digit or a 2 digit number Divide a number up to 4 digits by a digit number. Interpret remainders Solve problems involving multiplication, division and remainders.
