An Overview of the Theme

This half-term, we continue to look at extreme earth across the world. We continue to develop our understanding of why natural disasters happen, including developing an understanding of volcanoes, earthquakes, tsunamis and tornados and why they occur and the impact they have on people around the world, specifically the 2010 disaster in Haiti.

English Your child will be writing a setting description, a recount and creating their own book to share.	 This half herm, we will be writing a creative setting description based on the book called Ratty's Big Adventure. We will be using a range of literary devices to make our writing stand out including expanded noun phrases, ambitious vocabulary, and similes. We will also be writing a recount and innovating a text with our own amazing imaginative ideas. We will be developing our reading skills with a range of non fiction texts as well as continuing our key text: 'The Fire Work Maker's Daughter.'
Mathematics Your child will be learning all about multiplication and division and Measurement.	 Write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables that they know, including for two-digit numbers times one-digit numbers, using mental and progressing to formal written methods- multiplication and division Solve problems, including missing number problems, involving multiplication and division, including positive integer scaling problems and correspondence problems in which n objects are connected to m objects Measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm); mass (kg/g); volume/capacity (l/ml) Measure the perimeter of simple 2-D shapes
