Dear Parents and Carers,

Over the course of the last two weeks, there has been a number of incidents that have been reported to school that are happening between Year 6 pupils outside of school on Muirfield Park. These incidents appear to have happened when pupils have been playing on the park without adult supervision from a parent or carer, and are then being brought into school and creating further issues within the school environment.

In regards to the behaviour pupils off-site, our Trust behaviour policy states:

*Sanctions may be applied where a pupil has misbehaved off-site when representing the academy. This means misbehaviour when the pupil is:*

- *Taking part in any academy-organised or academy-related activity (e.g. trips)*
- *Travelling to or from the academy*
- *Wearing academy uniform*
- *In any other way identifiable as a pupil of our academy*

*Sanctions may also be applied where a pupil has misbehaved off-site, at any time, whether or not the conditions above apply, if the misbehaviour:*

- *Could have repercussions for the orderly running of the academy*
- *Poses a threat to another pupil*
- *Could adversely affect the reputation of the academy*

The issues that have been brought to our attention will be dealt with in school and we will be giving consideration to whether sanctions need to be implemented for specific pupils.

However, we are also asking for parents and carers to ensure that if your child is using the park or is arranging to meet with peers outside of school hours, they are appropriately supervised to prevent issues happening. Whilst we are happy to support parents and carers with issues that may occur outside of school, it is paramount that time in school is spent providing the best teaching and learning possible.
