Term: Summer 2

An Overview of the Theme

This half-term, we are continuing to learn about the Ancient Egyptian Civilisation. We will be using a range of historical inquiry skills to help us learn more about this period of history including chronology, comparing similarities and differences as well as interpreting different sources. We will be taking a virtual tour around the British Museum in London to learn about the wondrous artefacts from Ancient Egypt.

- This half term, we will be learning how to innovate an adventure story using inspiration from the Ancient Egypt Sleepover. We will be learning to write a Diary entry about the life of a Pharaoh. Finally, we will be writing a persuasive job advert for a Pharaoh.

- add and subtract fractions with the same denominator.
- recognise, find and write fractions of a discrete set of objects.
- add and subtract amounts of money to give change.
- tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals.
- estimate and read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute; record and compare time in terms of seconds, minutes and hours; use vocabulary such as o'clock, a.m./p.m., morning, afternoon, noon and midnight
- know the number of seconds in a minute and the number of days in each month, year and leap year
- compare durations of events.
- recognise angles as a property of shape or a description of a turn.
- draw 2-D shapes and make 3-D shapes.
- recognise 3-D shapes in different orientations; and describe them
- identify horizontal and vertical lines and pairs of perpendicular and parallel line
- interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables
- solve one-step and two-step questions .
